Jane MacQuitty picks eleven red wines

2008 Polago Azienda Agricola Vallesanta, Umbria, *Italy*

Majestic Wine, £7.49 Bang next door to Orvieto in the hills overlooking Lake Corbara close to the Tiber river, Vallesanta's sangiovese and montepulciano vines are grown on superior "Classica" land where vineyards and olive groves have been cultivated since the Etruscan era. Today this delicious sweet, herby, wild cherry and damson plum layered Italian was another star red contender and a fine red to serve with beef carpaccio, or bresaola.
